Harris County 4-H Dog Project is an opportunity for youth to gain experience learning to care for their dogs and become responsible pet owners. The project will offer seven weeks of Obedience Training conducted by Dog Trainer, Candy Powell at Spring Creek Park located at 15012 Brown Rd, Tomball, TX 77375. The obedience sessions will be conducted from October 27 to December 15 on Monday evenings from 7:00 -8:00 pm at a fee of \$10 per session payable in two intervals \$40 for 1st 4 weeks and \$30 for the final 3 weeks.
